






## Me And My World - Reception - Autumn Term 1<sup>st</sup> Half 2022

Overview of topic	What we will learn		
<p>This half term in Reception, our topic will be <i>Me And My World</i>. We will discuss our likes and dislikes and what makes us unique, as well as talking about our homes and families. The children will be working on building relationships with their peers and adults, developing routines, and exploring their classroom and the embankment area. We will be learning about habitats, seasonal changes and our local area. 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<p><b>By the end of the half term, what knowledge, skills and experiences will the children have had?</b></p> <p>Knowledge – The children will gain an understanding of seasonal changes, habitats and the animals that visit the embankment (e.g. foxes, squirrels, hedgehogs, insects, owls, bats). They will have a deep knowledge and understanding of numbers to 5.</p> <p>Skills – The children will develop their fine and gross motor skills, reading and mark making skills, and vocabulary and story sequencing skills.</p> <p>Experiences – Nature walks in the embankment; making a hedgehog house; nature art and making paintbrushes from natural materials; show and tell; talking about our families and people in our community; apple picking and making apple juice.</p>		<b>Maths</b>	<p>To count objects, actions and sounds.</p> <p>To link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value.</p>

		<b>Expressive Arts and Design</b>	<p>To join in with role play activities.</p> <p>To develop storylines in pretend play.</p> <p>To explore a variety of drawing tools and tell stories through pictures.</p> <p>To explore textures in the natural world.</p> <p>To explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups.</p>
