Dear Parents and Carers,

We can't let the term pass without communicating how happy we are with how hard our children have worked over the past year. This year has been incredibly challenging. We have had two major inspections, both of which confirmed that Princess Frederica is a good school. We would like to thank all staff members for their hard work throughout the year and for helping to produce fantastic results.

## Key Stage 2

This year's Key Stage 2 results are a great achievement. Big thanks goes to the Year 6 team including Mr Sowa, Ms Yerlisu, Mr Richards, Ms Simpson, Miss Barron and Mr Thompson. This achievement involved lots of different strategies including specialist teaching from a secondary and primary trained maths teacher, reciprocal reading, booster classes, grouped tuitions for higher attainers and many other initiatives. Also, a very big well done to the children who worked incredibly hard through the year and tried their absolute best. We, as a school, are immensely proud of them.

- In reading, 91% of children at PF achieved the expected standard compared to 81% last year.
- In reading, 61% of children at PF achieved the expected standard in greater depth (GD) compared to 40% last year. Last year, the national average for GD was 19%.
- Percentage of children achieving the expected standard in the following subjects was higher than last year in all areas and higher than national average: Grammar (96%), writing (86%), maths (91%) and science (93%).
- Percentage of children achieving the expected standard in greater depth in the following subjects was higher than last year in all areas and higher than national average: Grammar (43%) and maths (41%).
- In reading and maths, the average scaled score for Princess Frederica was 110. This means that the cohort, on average, was working at a greater depth standard.
