

You can ask your child to trace its shape in the air or go over the dotted one I have included. What do they notice about the shape of it?

Subtracting


Gather 6 objects together and arrange them on a surface.

Count the objects together and then ask your child to take one away. How many are there now? Can they do the sum in their heads or do they need to recount?

Now, ask them to take away two objects. How many do they have now? Make sure that as they count, they touch each object in turn. Do they try to include the objects they have taken away in their counting? If they do, try again and completely remove the taken away objects from their line of view. Ask them to tell you in a sentence what has just happened.

Are they able to draw or write to show the maths they have just done? How do they represent taking away? Drawing pictures often helps children understand what is happening in these simple exercises.

Numberblocks have an online game about adding and subtracting. It includes mathematical symbols and will require an adult to read out the questions. The format is very child-friendly and can encourage children to use the information they have learnt through the practical exercises you have already done. www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/puzzles/numberblocks-number-magic-adding-and-subtracting
