## **Facts**

- Palm Sunday. The start of Holy Week, when Jesus rode in Jerusalem on a donkey. Palm leaves were placed on the ground in front of him.
- Maundy Thursday. Jesus had the Last Supper with his disciples and shared bread and wine with them. Holy Communion represents this meal.
- Good Friday. When Jesus died on the cross.
  Christians believe Jesus died for the sins of others.
  He was placed in a stone tomb.
- Easter Sunday. The resurrection of Jesus. Christians believe this symbolises the promise of eternal life in heaven.
- The 10 Commandments are God's rules for living and Christians (and Jews) believe them to be rules that they are commanded to follow.
- The Torah contains part of the Old Testament.
