### Facts


- Christians believe that although death is very sad, living a Christian life ensures that when they die, Christians will lead an eternal life with God in Heaven.
- Traditional Buddhists believe that when people die they are reborn as another being - and not always as a human being.
- Hindus believe in reincarnation. They believe that death is the start of a long sleep for the soul, before it sets out on a new life. Hindus believe that death is part of the cycle of life and is what happens before you set out on a new life.
- Jews believe that the soul of the departed goes to Heaven.
- For a Muslim, death is the return of the soul to their Creator, Allah


