

Week 1, Day 2: Tuesday 24th March

Reading: Choose one online e-book for your child to read today (or one from your own library). Remember to record the book in your child's yellow reading record.

Go to the pink tab (My Class Login) at the top of the page and enter your child's class login details. On the home page click e-books - My Bookshelf.

Remember to develop comprehension skills by asking your child questions, e.g. What do you think this book is about? How do you know? What tells you that? Also, ask recall questions about what they have read, the characters, etc. Please introduce new vocabulary and explain the meaning when necessary.

Maths: Last week we were learning about 3D shapes - cube, cuboid, cylinder, cone and sphere. Record what you found on your shape hunt yesterday in your home learning book.

Phonics: Ask your child to read **page one** (first four) of the yes and no question cards (see below) and answer the questions.

Expressive Arts Design: Please continue to collect junk modelling/baking resources for future activities.

Last week we read Mrs Armitage on Wheels which the children really enjoyed. Encourage your child to design/draw a bike – you can use any arts and crafts resources that you may have at home.

Handwriting: Today use your letter formation card to practise your letter formation. Remember to clean it off when you are done for the next day.

Writing: Can you label the bike that you designed in your art activity?

Physical Development: Using a timer, count how many star jumps you can do in one minute. How many times can you touch your toes in one minute? (If possible, also go for a ride on your bike/scooter in your local area or around your house)

Understanding the World: Remember to water your plant today and place it in a nice, warm place with lots of light to help it grow. Remember, if your plant gets too much water it will be tricky for it to grow.
