## **Facts**

- The Qur'an is the Muslim holy book.
- The Five Pillars of Islam are the five religious duties expected of every Muslim.
- The five pillars are called Shahada, Salat, Zakat, Sawam, Hajj
- Shahada means profession of faith and Salat means praying 5 times a day.
- Zakat means giving to charity, Sawam is fasting and Hajj is a pilgrimage to Mecca, the holy city of Islam.
- Before any prayer, Wudu must be performed. This is a ritual

- Ramadan: Muslim month of fasting.
- Ka'bah: The cubed shaped structure in the centre of grand mosque in Makkah.
- Makkah: City where the prophet Mohammad was born
- Prayer mat: A mat used to pray on.
- Commitment: dedicating yourself to something.
- Wudu: Ritual washing before prayer.
- Muslim: A believer of the religion of Islam.
- Islam: Arabic word meaning 'submission' to the will of God.
