<b>God</b>	The creator and ruler of the universe for Christians.
<b>Bible</b>	A special book for Christians that teaches us about God and how to live.
<b>Torah</b>	A special book for Jewish people (this is also the Old Testament for Christians).
<b>Commandment</b>	A rule or instruction from God.
<b>Salvation</b>	Saving a person from sin.
<b>Disciple</b>	A follower of Jesus.
<b>Crucifixion</b>	The way in which Jesus died; the Romans nailed him to a cross.
<b>Tomb</b>	A place where someone is buried.
<b>Resurrection</b>	When God brought Jesus back to life.

### Ten Commandments

Key question: What are God's rules for living?

Christians believe that when God created us, he gave us rules to guide us and keep us safe. They are known as the Ten Commandments. You might remember them from the Torah when we learned about Judaism last term!

<b>1</b> No other gods besides God.	<b>2</b> No idols, worship only God.
<b>3</b> Always treat God's name with respect.	<b>4</b> Have a day to rest and thank God every week.
<b>5</b> Obey your parents.	<b>6</b> Do not hurt others with words or actions.
<b>7</b> Keep your promises to others and God.	<b>8</b> Do not steal from others.
<b>9</b> Always tell the truth.	<b>10</b> Do not be jealous or envious of others.

### Easter

Key question: Why is Easter the most important festival for Christians?



**Palm Sunday** - when Jesus entered into Jerusalem on a donkey.

**Maundy Thursday** - also known as the Last Supper, this is when Jesus ate a meal with his twelve disciples.



**Good Friday** - the day Jesus was crucified and died on the cross.

**Easter Sunday** - when Jesus rose from the dead
