

<b>Judaism</b>	A religion. Jewish people believe that there is only one God.
<b>Torah</b>	A special text for Jewish people that teaches them about God and how to live.
<b>Yad</b>	A pointer used for reading the Torah.
<b>Tallith</b>	A shawl worn by Jewish men during morning prayer.
<b>Kippah</b>	A small cap worn by Jewish men and boys.
<b>Synagogue</b>	A place of worship for Jewish people.
<b>Shabbat</b>	A day of rest, beginning at sunset on Friday and ending at sunset on Saturday.
<b>Rabbi</b>	A religious leader in the Jewish community.
<b>Star of David</b>	A Jewish symbol.
<b>Menorah</b>	A special candle holder used during the Jewish holiday Hanukkah.



## Year 1 RE Judaism



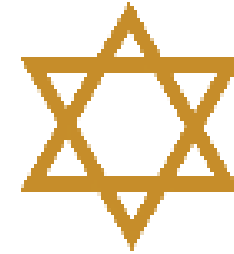
In RE, we learn about thinking, believing and living.
