| steam engine | An engine that uses steam from boiling water to make it move. |

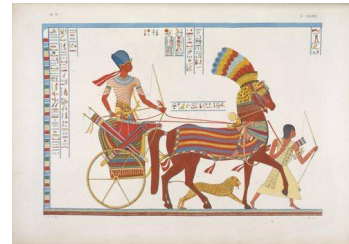
The Model T Ford was invented by Henry Ford. Before this, most people could not afford a car. The Model T Ford was cheaper, which meant that more families could own a car and drive.

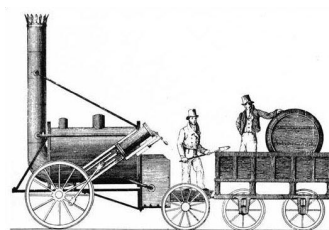


History is the study of the past, in particular changes over time.
