

## Who was Boudicca and why do we remember her?

## Why did the Romans invade Britain?

The Roman emperors wanted their empire to be as big and powerful as possible. They conquered large areas of land for natural resources, such as precious metals, slaves, and farmland to grow crops, to feed the army and the large population in Rome.

Britain contained a large amount of natural resources- such as gold, iron, lead, salt, silver and tin. Iron can be used to make weapons and helmets.


