

Agni: Sacred fire

reverence for all living things.

Ashrama: Stage in life

Dharma: Dharma is a person's duty, the right thing to do in any

given situation.

Karma: The law of cause and effect, the idea that every action

has a consequence, which can be either positive or negative.

Moksha: Liberation for the soul from samsara

Samsara: The unsatisfactory cycle of life, death and rebirth.

Samskaras: acts of purifying, refining and

developing the body and mind, at key points in life.

Sanatan Dharma: The eternal way (many Hindus

prefer this to the term 'Hinduism')

Saptapadi: Most important part of the wedding

ceremony where the couple take seven steps

Atman: Soul

Kanyadaan: Giving away the bride
