

Knowledge Organiser – Faith: Christianity - Liturgy

Big question: Why is liturgy important to many Christians?

Liturgy – a fixed form of worship used in Christian churches.

Blessing – a prayer that blesses people.

Communion (or Eucharist or Mass) – a Christian ceremony in which bread and wine are blessed and shared.

Gospel – a book of the Bible about Jesus's life

Epistle – a book in the Bible which is a letter written to Christians.

Psalm – a song in the Bible.

Confession – saying sorry to God.

Intercession – praying for people

Rite - a religious ceremony.

Ritual – the actions used in a religious ceremony.

Sacrament – a Christian religious ceremony.
