Uniform

Library

- Children will have the opportunity to browse and borrow books from our school library **once every 4 weeks.**
- Children will be able to borrow **at least 2 books** per visit provided that they return all outstanding loaned books.
- **Our library date this half term is Friday 9th October**



Reading

- Children are encouraged to have a reading book to read both in school and at home.
- Children will also be provided with colour banded or levelled books to further support their reading and comprehension.
- Once completed, children must return these books in exchange for new ones.



Reading Records

- Please check your child's reading record to ensure that it's being completed daily.
- Children are to record books read everyday or pages read if it's a chapter book.



Spelling



- The school will soon be introducing a new spelling scheme for children which is computer friendly and ensures continuity if there was another school lock-down.
