Facts

- **Batik** is an Indonesian technique of wax-resist dyeing applied to whole cloth. The technique originated from Java, Indonesia. Batik is made either by drawing dots and lines of the resist with a spouted tool called a tjanting, or by printing the resist with a copper stamp called cap.
- The applied wax resists dyes and therefore allows the artisan to colour selectively by painting fabric using special fabric prints.
