## **Physical features**

- Russia, the largest country in the world, occupies one-tenth of all the land on Earth.
- Russia has about 100,000 rivers
- The Russian landscape varies from desert to frozen coastline, tall mountains to giant marshes.
- Japan is a collection of 5
  islands: Kyushu, Honshu,
  Shikoku, Hokkaido and
  Okinawa. There are also 6,847
  smaller islands in Japan.
- Mount Fiji is a major volcano in Japan.

## **Human features**

- Agriculture is an important part of the economy in many Asian countries where the main food crop is rice.
- The Yangtze River is important for the fishing trade of Asia.
- The Three Gorges Dam is in China control floods and generates 22,250 megawatts of electricity for the country.
- There are a huge variety of cuisines and most are produced from local resources (e.g. fish in Japan).

- It is the largest continent in the world and covers roughly 30% of the earth's land surface.
- 60% of the world's population lives in Asia making is the most populated content in the world.
