

Facts

- Rules and laws are guidelines for how people should behave. They are based on ideas about what is right and wrong.
- Laws are rules that have been passed by a government. If someone breaks the law, a crime has been committed and that person is usually punished.
- A responsibility is something you are expected to do.
 It might be a task or it might be a way you are expected to act.
- Every religion has a creed, which is a statement of the basic beliefs of a religious faith or a set of guiding rules or beliefs.
