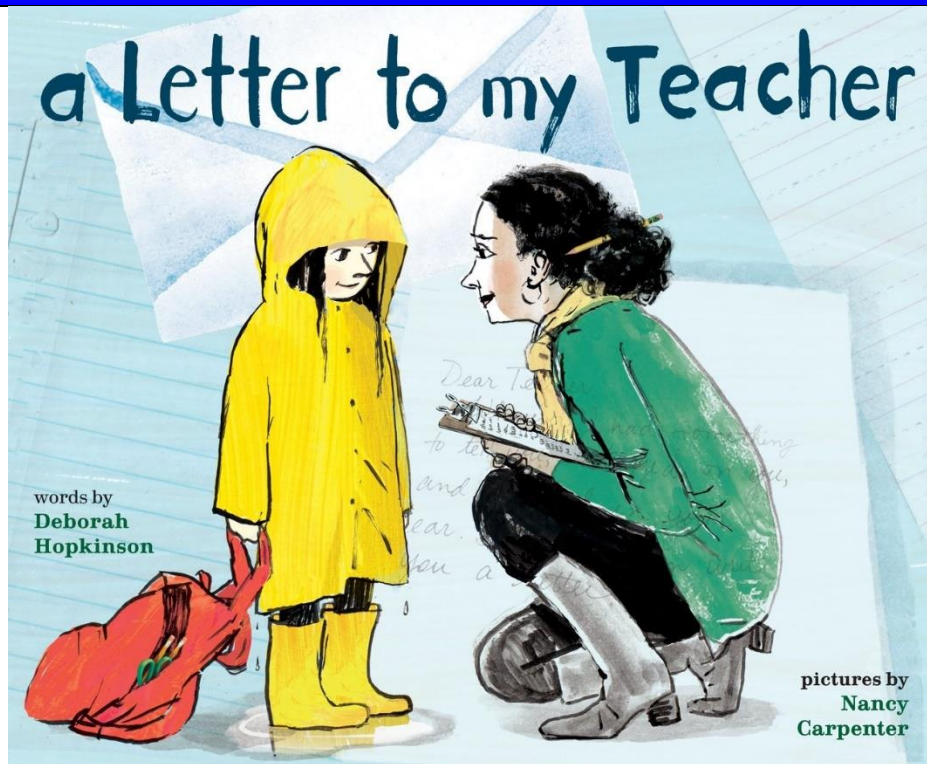

Writing

Wednesday and Thursday LO: to write the body of a letter

Reading

Using the extract practise writing:

- x3 **on the line questions**
- x3 **between the lines questions**
- x3 **beyond the text question**

Once you have finished ask your parent or sibling to answer them for you and mark their answers.

Tips to help:

On-the-line questions

Remember, these are simple questions that the reader can find and retrieve from the text.

e.g. Make a list of the things the monster damages as it approaches.

Between the lines

Remember, these are questions that you need to infer (work out) from clues in the text. The answer is not always obvious.

e.g. What is it that the monster destroys?

Beyond the text questions

Remember, these are questions you can link to your own life experiences or perhaps to other art (books, films, tv) that you have encountered. The answer to these questions is not written in the text – the reader needs to work out the answers.

Maths

Lesson 8 – Converting units of time

In this lesson, we will solve problems where we have to convert between units of time, including those where there is a remainder.

Key vocabulary: remainder, multiple, second, minute, hour, day, week, month, year

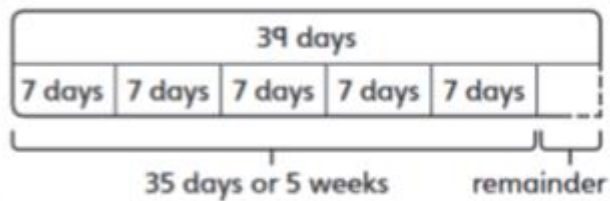
There are 7 days in 1 week. 39 is not a multiple of 7, so I predict that there will be a remainder.



$$39 \div 7 = 5 \text{ remainder } 4$$

So 39 days = 5 weeks and 4 days

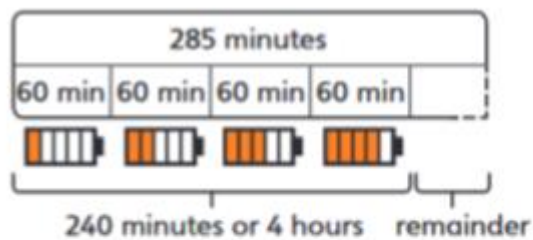
Toshi has had his phone for 5 weeks and 4 days.



b) 60 minutes = 1 hour

285 minutes is between 240 and 300 minutes.

285 minutes = 4 hours and a remainder of minutes



Amal's phone should have 4 bars fully charged.

$$285 - 240 = 45$$

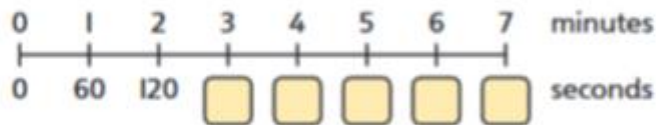
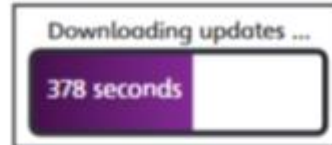
Amal's phone has been charging for 4 hours and 45 minutes.

$$60 - 45 = 15$$

There are 15 minutes left until the next bar is charged.

Think together

- 1 Amal's phone is downloading updates. How many minutes has his phone been downloading updates for?



Count in 60s.

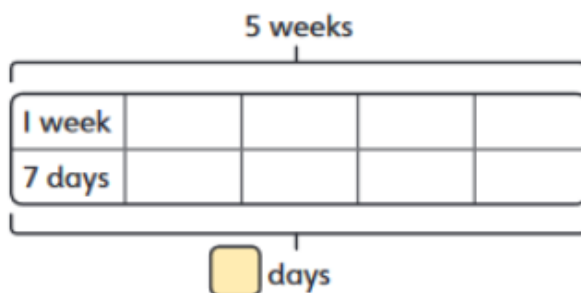
378 is between and .

So there are minutes and there will be a remainder of seconds.

$$5 \text{ weeks} = 5 \times 7 = \text{} \text{ days}$$

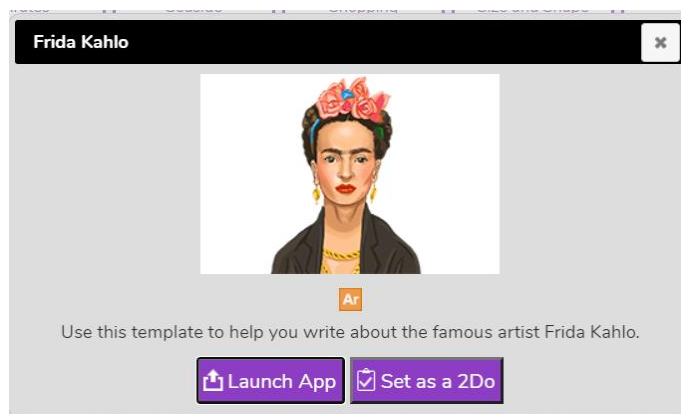
