This week we will be learning spellings for the year 5 list of words to know. Please practise learning the words every day by putting the words in sentences and get an adult to test you on Friday.

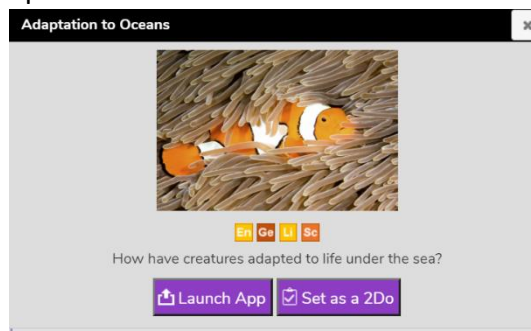

This week we are going to be researching how different creatures have adapted to life under the sea.
