English Day 4

Task 4:

Make sure you include fronted adverbials, figurative language, powerful vocabulary, relative clauses, dialogue and parentheses.

Subtracting fractions 1

Discover



- 1 a) Amelia waters some flowers.
She uses $\frac{2}{10}$ of a litre of water from her watering can.
How much water does she have left?
- b) How much more water than Danny does Amelia have now?

Share

a) Amelia has $2\frac{9}{10}$ litres of water.



Amelia uses $\frac{2}{10}$ of a litre.



$$2\frac{9}{10} - \frac{2}{10} = 2\frac{7}{10}$$

Amelia has $2\frac{7}{10}$ litres of water left.

I will subtract the $\frac{2}{10}$ from the $\frac{9}{10}$ as the denominators are the same.

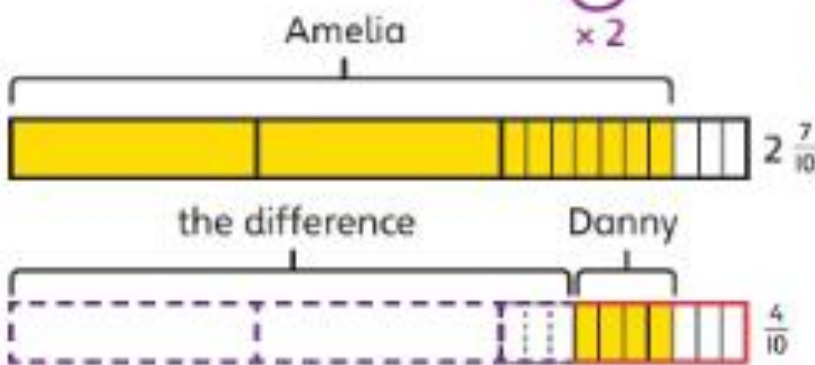


b) To work out the difference, subtract $\frac{2}{5}$ from $2\frac{7}{10}$.

Find a common denominator:

$$\frac{2}{5} = \frac{4}{10}$$

$\times 2$
 $\times 2$



$$2\frac{7}{10} - \frac{4}{10} = 2\frac{3}{10}$$

Amelia has $2\frac{3}{10}$ litres more water than Danny.

I will convert $\frac{2}{5}$ to $\frac{4}{10}$ and then use a diagram to help me subtract this from $2\frac{7}{10}$.
