- sub-headings used correctly
- rhetorical questions and did you know boxes
- nice pictures and captions

Where could you find your animal?

Where does it live?

What does it do?

How many different types there are?

Is your animal close to extinction?

Any interesting facts/ Did you know?

Maths Day 2

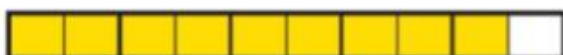


- 1 a) Lexi uses $2\frac{1}{6}$ packs of stickers on her card.
How many packs of stickers does she have left?
- b) Alex cuts off a piece of straw that is $2\frac{3}{5}$ cm long.
How long is the straw she has left?

Share

- a) Lexi started with $4\frac{1}{2}$ packs of stickers and used $2\frac{1}{6}$ packs, so find $4\frac{1}{2} - 2\frac{1}{6}$.

Convert mixed numbers to improper fractions:



$$4\frac{1}{2} = \frac{9}{2}$$



$$2\frac{1}{6} = \frac{13}{6}$$

A common denominator is 6:

$$\begin{array}{c} \times 3 \\ \curvearrowright \\ \frac{9}{2} = \frac{27}{6} \\ \curvearrowleft \\ \times 3 \end{array}$$

$$\frac{27}{6} - \frac{13}{6} = \frac{14}{6}$$



Convert the answer back to a mixed number:

$$\frac{14}{6} = 2\frac{2}{6} = 2\frac{1}{3}$$



Lexi has $2\frac{1}{3}$ packs of stickers left.

I will convert each number to an improper fraction and then subtract. I need to make sure the denominators are the same before I subtract.



- b) $12\frac{3}{10} - 2\frac{3}{5}$

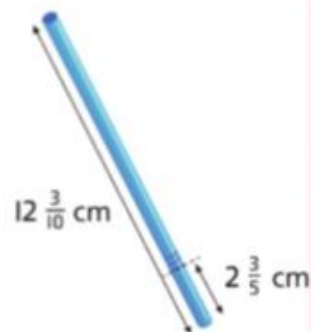
Change to improper fractions: $= \frac{123}{10} - \frac{13}{5}$

Make the denominators equal: $= \frac{123}{10} - \frac{26}{10}$

Subtract: $= \frac{97}{10}$

Convert back to a mixed number: $= 9\frac{7}{10}$ cm

The straw that Alex has left is $9\frac{7}{10}$ cm long.
