# Our curriculum:

## **Mathematics**

*I can:*

- use place value to compare and order numbers up to 1,000,000
- add and subtract numbers with more than four digits
- multiply and divide numbers using formal written methods

## **Reading**

*I can:*

- identify how an author's language such as descriptive phrases impact and effect the reader
- make inferences about a character's thoughts and feelings
- retrieve and record information from a non-fiction text

## **Writing**

*I can:*

- draft and write by organising paragraphs around a theme in narratives: creating settings, characters and plot
- draft and write by organising paragraphs around a theme in non-narrative material
- use commas to clarify meaning or avoid ambiguity in my writing (to separate main and subordinate clauses)

# Our curriculum:

- Geography: Local area study and Mapping
- History: Early Islamic Civilisation
- Religious Education: The miracles of Jesus and Art and music conveying Christmas
- Science: Materials and Forces
- Computing: Online safety and Concept maps
- Art/DT: Making Lino prints, Christmas biscuits
